#### HARVEST

The 2023 harvest in Casablanca Valley was marked by an optimal balance of sunny days and cool nights, providing excellent conditions for slow and even ripening of Sauvignon Blanc grapes. The absence of extreme weather events allowed for a stress-free maturation period, leading to grapes with a balance of sugar and acidity, reflecting the unique terroir of the region.

#### TASTING NOTES

The 2023 Peñalolen Sauvignon Blanc gleams with a straw hue with subtle greenish reflections. It presents an intricate bouquet, where hints of lime zest, green apple, and a whisper of tropical mango intermingle with a light herbal undertone reminiscent of fresh-cut grass. On the palate, it exhibits a harmony between zesty citrus flavors and a minerality that speaks to the coastal influences of Casablanca. A crisp acidity anchors the wine, leading to a refreshing finish that lingers with nuances of kiwi and a hint of white pepper.
